# 1. Introduction

Inxpect is committed to conducting its business ethically, sustainably, and in accordance with the principles of integrity and social responsibility. We expect our suppliers to share these values, helping to ensure a supply chain that respects human rights, legality, and the environment.

Although we do not directly purchase raw minerals, we recognize that our products may, even indirectly, contain minerals such as tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold (3TG), as well as extended minerals like cobalt and mica, which can be linked to irresponsible mining practices, especially in Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas (CAHRAs).

# 2. Our Commitment

Inxpect:

- Acknowledges the social and environmental issues associated with the extraction of these materials, particularly in the Democratic Republic of Congo and surrounding countries.
- Has implemented an internal process to gather information on the origin of minerals contained in our products, despite operating several tiers away from mining activities.
- Uses and promotes industry-standard tools, namely:
  - the **CMRT** (Conflict Minerals Reporting Template) for 3TG
  - the **EMRT** (Extended Minerals Reporting Template) for minerals such as cobalt and mica.
- Works collaboratively with suppliers to assess risks, promote transparency, and encourage the use of conformant smelters and refiners, as validated by recognized initiatives (e.g. RMI – Responsible Minerals Initiative).

# 3. Suppliers Requirements

Inxpect asks its suppliers to:

- Implement responsible sourcing policies aligned with this document.
- Provide, upon request, complete and accurate information on the origin of 3TG, cobalt, and mica in the products supplied, using the CMRT and/or EMRT templates.
- Fully cooperate with our team during due diligence activities and support the resolution of any identified supply chain risks.

Non-compliance with this policy may lead to a review of the business relationship.
